Items needed for Pre-Camp:

- I. Great attitude and enthusiasm!
- 2. Instrument or Practice Flag and/or Baton, etc.
- 3. Appropriate shoes for marching. NO sandals, flip flops, or shoes with heels.
- 4. Sunscreen SPF40 and up.
- 5. A wide-brimmed hat.
- 6. Plenty of water or Powerade-type drink for breaks.
- 7. Athletic type clothing appropriate for school. Don't wear jeans of sweaters to rehearsal.

All-State Auditions are SOON!



The 2021-2022 Florida Bandmasters Association All-State Band is a great experience for any band member. Students passing the audition go to Tampa in January for several days and perform with other outstanding musicians from our state.

Any band member interested in auditioning for the 2021-2022 F.B.A. All-State Band should get the materials appropriate for your instrument. **You need to do this right away**. A list of the audition materials can be found <u>here</u>. https://mrgermans.weebly.com/fallmusicianship-testing.html

Please read carefully the regulations and requirements for your instrument. Check the site often for updates to make sure you are working on the <u>correct</u> material.

There will be students who audition for the all-state bands who have worked on this material all summer, have taken workshops over the all-state material, and who have been studying privately. <u>This</u> is your competition. All-State band members are always well prepared to audition.

One of our band's goals is to have one or more band members from every section in the all-state band. Go Timberwolves! Let me hear you play early so I can help you get ready!

BBADB AUDITIONS:

The Big Bend All District Band audition materials are taken from the 9th and 10th grade all-state material. So get an early start for this reason alone. We want to beat our record number of 19.

Leadership:

I recommend that you try to get some sort of waterproof set book. Either a waterproof binder, or a bag that you can put a binder into to keep it dry. This keeps books from being ruined and having to pay to be recreated.
